

ROYAL LONDON SERIES, ONE-DAY TOUR MATCHES AND ROYAL LONDON U19 ONE-DAY INTERNATIONALS

Standard ICC ODI playing conditions shall apply with the following variations:

2 THE UMPIRES

2.1 Appointment and attendance

2.1.13

Umpires for One-Day tour matches and for Royal London U19 One-Day Internationals shall be appointed from the ECB First-Class Umpires' List

2.8 Suspension of play in dangerous or unreasonable circumstances

2.8.5

In One-Day tour matches and Royal London U19 ODIs, ECB shall provide Umpires with lightmeters.

2.8.6 Use of artificial lights

Shall apply with the addition of the following:

In Day/Night Matches, the floodlights will be turned on at the interval between innings or at 7.00pm, whichever is the earlier.

4 THE BALL

4.2 Approval and control of balls

4.2.1 shall be replaced by the following:

The ECB (home authority in the case of One-Day tour matches and Royal London U19 One-Day Internationals) shall provide cricket balls of an approved standard for ODI cricket and spare used balls for changing during a match which shall also be of the same brand. Grade 1 white balls manufactured by Kookaburra shall be used. Note: The Home Board shall be required to advise the Visiting Boards of the brand of ball to be used in the match(es) at least 30 days prior to the start of the match(es).

7 THE CREASES

7.3 The Popping Crease

This playing condition shall only apply in One-Day tour matches and Royal London Under 19 One-Day Internationals if the match is televised.

10 COVERING THE PITCH

10.2 During the match

Shall be replaced by the following:

The pitch shall be entirely protected against rain up to the commencement of play and for the duration of the period of the match.

The covers must totally protect the pitch and also the pitch surroundings, to a minimum 5 metres (20 feet in One-Day tour matches and Royal London Under 19 One-Day Internationals) either side of the pitch and any worn or soft areas in the outfield.

The bowler's run-ups shall be covered during inclement weather, in order to keep them dry, to a distance of at least 10 x 10 metres (10 x 4 yards in One-Day tour matches and Royal London Under 19 One-Day Internationals).

12 START OF PLAY; CESSATION OF PLAY

12.7 Hours of Play; Minimum Overs Requirement

Scheduled start and cessation times are as follows:

Day/Night Matches v Australia

First Session	1.00pm – 4.30pm
Interval	4.30pm – 5.00pm
Second Session	5.00pm – 8.30pm

Day/Night Matches v Ireland

First Session	12.30pm – 4.00pm
Interval	4.00pm – 4.30pm
Second Session	4.30pm – 8.00pm

Start times in One-Day Tour Matches and Royal London Under 19 One-Day Internationals shall be separately agreed.

13 INNINGS

13.6 Duration of Match

13.6.1 shall apply. No reserve days have been allocated to any match.

13.7 Length of Innings

13.7.1.5, 13.7.2.1.6 and 13.7.2.2.7 (Penalties for slow over-rates) shall not apply in One-Day Tour Matches and Royal London Under 19 One-Day Internationals.

13.8 Extra Time

Provision has been made for up to 30 minutes of extra official playing time in Royal London Series Day Matches to make up for playing time lost. Extra time in One-Day Tour Matches and Royal London U19 One-Day Internationals shall be separately agreed.

16 THE RESULT

16.11 Royal London Series

In the Royal London One-Day Series, the team that wins the most matches shall be deemed the winner of the series. In the event of both teams winning the same number of matches, the series shall be deemed drawn.
